TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS

You are responsible for securing your own air travel arrangements. The closest major airport is the St. Louis Lambert International Airport. If you plan to arrive the first day of the event, August 1, we recommend scheduling a flight to arrive prior to 11:00 a.m. Registration will open at 11:00 a.m. and lunch will be available with presentations starting promptly at 12:30 p.m. The Chesterfield Research Center is located approximately 30-45 minutes from the airport depending on traffic.

For your departure on August 2, we recommend that you schedule flights departing after 3:00 p.m. The Jerseyville Agronomy Center is located approximately 1 hour from the airport depending on traffic. The shuttles will leave the facility at 12:15 p.m. and take guests directly to the airport or the hotel.

GROUND TRANSPORTATION

Upon your arrival, you will need to make your own travel arrangements from the airport to the hotel or the Chesterfield Research Center.

On Day 1, we will provide shuttle services for our guests in the late morning from the Drury Plaza Hotel Chesterfield to the Chesterfield Research Center. For Day 2, we will also provide shuttle service from the Drury Plaza Hotel to the Jerseyville Agronomy Center. At the conclusion of the event, we will return guests to St. Louis Lambert International Airport and the Drury Plaza Hotel.
