

April 2012 traffic

Vueling increases the number of passengers carried in April by 22.3%

The company increases its load factor by 3.6 points year-on-year, reaching a 76.9% load factor

Barcelona, 8th May 2012. – Vueling, the new generation airline, has carried 1,200,140 passengers in April 2012. This represents a 22.3% increase compared to April 2011. The company has reached a load factor of 76.9%, 3.6 points higher than last year.
