

Vueling carried 8.2 million passengers in 2009

It became the second most punctual airline in Europe, with 83.92% of flights arriving on time

Barcelona, January 13th, 2009. – Vueling, the new-generation airline, carried 8.2 million passengers during 2009, with an average seat-load factor of 73.7%—a 3.4-point increase with regards to 2008.

Vueling reached the 25-millionth passenger mark in 2009, after slightly over 5 years of operations. Passenger volumes greatly increased during the year thanks to its merger with Clickair, and after the fall registered in 2008, as a consequence of the company's fleet reduction plan.
