

June traffic note 2011

Vueling increases by 22% the number of passengers carried in June

The firm increases the number of passengers carried with respect to previous year by 22%, reaching a total of 1.2 million passengers

Barcelona, 13th July 2011. – Vueling, the new generation ariline, has carried 1,185,921 passengers in June 2011. This reprsents a 22% raise compared to June 2010. The company has reached a load factor of 73.8%, 2.6 points higher than last year.

Connections, international bases and new routes

Vueling continues its growth driven by new international bases in Toulouse and Amsterdam as well as the operation in Madrid airport that allows Vueling to feed Iberia long haul flights.

Moreover, during summer season the company will launch 26 new routes. These routes will increase Vueling's route offering and will contribute to consolidate traffic growth.
