




Shareholding structure




Evolution of the share prices until August 31st 2006

(Base index 100= 31.12.04)






Consolidated Operating Revenues






Consolidated Operating Profit (EBIT)






Net Profit Part Group






Consolidated Shareholders' Equity







Tender for the Desalination Plant in El Prat

- July 2006: Awarding for the construction and further management of the Desalination Plant in El Prat del Llobregat (Barcelona).
- Production capacity: 60 Hm³/year.
- The winning joint venture is made up of:
 - Sociedad General de Aguas de Barcelona, S.A.
 - DRAGADOS
 - DRACE
 - DEGRÉMONT
- Tendering budget: 150 MEUR. 75% of the project is financed by EU cohesion funds.


- Aguas Andinas negotiated and signed with the Government of Chile the new tariff framework for the five-year period 2005-2009.
- April 2006: IAM (56,6% Agbar) placed in the Chilean stock market 1.1% of Aguas Andinas.
 - Transaction amount: 19.7 MEUR
 - IAM keeps a 50.102% stake in Aguas Andinas


- Agbar announced on April 21st 2006 a takeover bid for the acquisition of 100% of Bristol Water Group plc.
 - Transaction amount: GBP 170 million.
 - Friendly takeover bid: the Board of Directors of Bristol Water recommends its shareholders to accept it.
- Bristol Water Group plc. serves one million people (475,000 clients) in an area of about 2,400 km² in the city of Bristol and its surroundings.
- Perpetual concession. Bristol Water is the owner of the assets.
- Final outlay of the operation: 240.3 MEUR






Market share of Health Spain






Future projects

International expansion

- April 6th 2006: Applus+ acquired 100% of the Dutch group **Röntgen Technische Dienst (RTD)**, being its main activity the non-destructive testing and other inspection services in the petrochemical, chemical and energetic sectors.
 - Transaction amount: 193 MEUR
 - Estimated turnover in 2006: 150 MEUR
 - Estimated EBITDA in 2006: 20 MEUR
 - RTD is present in 11 countries, and concentrates its activity in Europe (70%)
 - Complementarity with the international presence of Applus +

International expansion

May 28th 2006: Applus+ acquired 100% of the second vehicle inspection operator in Finland, K1.



• K1 carries out 20% of the inspections in Finland, it employs 230 people and has 36 inspection centres in 29 towns.









Net Indebtedness / Net wealth


