

September traffic note 2011

Vueling increases by 22% the number of passengers carried in September

The company increases its load factor by 4.1 points year-on-year, reaching a 79.7% load factor

Barcelona, 11th October 2011. – Vueling, the new generation airline, has carried 1,261,089 passengers in September 2011. This represents a 21.6% raise compared to September 2010. The company has reached a load factor of 79.7%, 4.1 points higher than last year.

Vueling continues its growth driven by the new international bases in Toulouse and Amsterdam, the operation in Madrid airport that allows Vueling to feed Iberia long haul flights and the Vueling-Vueling and Vueling-Iberia connecting flights in Barcelona. Vueling has carried more than 500,000 connecting passengers since January'11.
