

January 2012 traffic note

Vueling increases the number of passengers carried in January by 13.3%

The company increases its load factor by 5.8 points year-on-year, reaching a 72.3% load factor

Barcelona, 10th February 2012. – Vueling, the new generation airline, has carried 727,704 passengers in January 2012. This represents a 13.3% increase compared to January 2011. The company has reached a load factor of 72.3%, 5.8 points higher than last year.

Increased capcity for summer 2012

Vueling will consolidate its leadership position in its Barcelona hub by increasing the offer for the 2012 summer season. Vueling will open 5 new routes in addition to those previously announced; Berlin and Hamburg from Barcelona, and Tenerife, Las Palmas and Lanzarote from Bilbao. Additionally, the summer program will be significantly strengthened with the addition of more frequencies in some of the existing routes.
