## Vueling carried 1,036,862 passengers in September, an increase of 8.5% year on year

The airline has also increased the traffic figures during the third quarter, transporting 3,494,036 passengers, an increase of 5.5% year on year.

**Barcelona, 6<sup>th</sup> October 2010.** – Vueling, the new generation airline, transported 3.494.036 passengers during the third quarter which represents an increase of 5.5% on the same period in 2009.

**ASK** (available seat-kilometer): number of seats flown multiplied by the number of miles flown

**RPK** (passenger-kilometers transported): number of passengers carried multiplied by the number of miles flown

### An increase in flight frequency on the main business routes

Among the reasons that have contributed to the increase in the number of passengers, Vueling highlights the increase in frequency of business routes. Up to 13 daily flights between Barcelona and Madrid, 9 between Barcelona and Paris and 6 between Barcelona and Seville are good examples that support this statement.
