FUJI CREDIT ASSET MANAGEMENT (OR FUJI CREDIT J-LLC)

The Financial Services and Markets Authority (FSMA) warns the public against the activities of Fuji Credit Asset Management (or Fuji Credit J-LLC), a company that offers investment services.

Fuji Credit Asset Management (or Fuji Credit J-LLC) is not an authorized investment firm in Belgium. It is therefore not allowed to provide investment services in or from Belgium.

Moreover, according to the information available to the FSMA, the activities proposed could be of a fraudulent nature, i.e. boiler room fraud. More information on this form of fraud is available in the general warning published by the FSMA on 4 May 2016.

The FSMA thus **strongly advises against responding to any offer of financial services** made by Fuji Credit Asset Management (Fuji Credit J-LLC) and **against transferring** money to any account number it might mention.

Fuji Credit Asset Management (Fuji Credit J-LLC) uses the website www.fujicredit.com, the email address clientservices@fujicredit.com and the phone number +81 645 604 600. It claims to have its registered office in Japan (Daiichi Fuji Building 2-12, Kawaramachi 2-chome, Chuo-ku, Osaka).

This company is also suspected of having ties with Mitsui Credit Global (Mitsui Credits) and Nippon Holdings (Nippon Capital Asset Management), two companies about which the FSMA has also published a warning.
