

Traffic Note November 2010

Vueling carried 776,854 passengers in November, a 4.4% increase year on year

The airline also increased its load factor by 1.6 percentage points in November

Barcelona, 9th December 2010. – Vueling, the new generation airline, carried 776,854 passengers in November 2010, which implies a 4.4% increase with respect to the same period last year.

New international bases in Amsterdam and Toulouse

International expansion will be Vueling's cornerstone to increase the number of passengers going forward. The airline will open in April 2011 two international bases in Toulouse and Amsterdam, which will offer for the summer season 200,000 and 636,000 seats, respectively. From the new bases, Vueling will operate not only routes to Spanish destinations but also new routes to other destinations outside Spain, with a significant presence of business travelers. Currently, the number of passengers flying on Vueling international routes already represents 46% of total passengers carried.
