## BYRON-STAFFORD

WARNINGS | 27/03/2020

The Financial Services and Markets Authority (FSMA) warns the public against the activities of Byron-Stafford, a company that offers investment services.

Byron-Stafford is not allowed to offer investment services in or from Belgium.

According to information available to the FSMA, moreover, this may be a case of fraudulent activity, and more particularly of 'boiler room' fraud. More information about this form of fraud is available in the [general warning](https://www.fsma.be/en/warnings/boiler-rooms-fsma-warns-public-against-unlawful-activities) that the FSMA published on 27 March 2020.



The FSMA thus strongly advises against responding to any offers of financial services made by Byron-Stafford and against transferring money to any account number that company might mention.
