## Vueling increases by 19% the number of passengers carried in August

The company increases its load factor by 1.6 points year-on-year, reaching a 83,7% load factor

**Barcelona, 8<sup>th</sup> September 2011.** – Vueling, the new generation ariline, has carried 1,543,218 passengers in August 2011. This represents a 19% raise compared to August 2010. The company has reached a load factor of 83.7%, 1.6 points higher than last year.

## Connections and international bases

Vueling continues its growth driven by the new international bases in Toulouse and Amsterdam, the operation in Madrid airport that allows Vueling to feed Iberia long haul flights and the Vueling-Vueling and Vueling-Iberia connecting flights in Barcelona.
