This notice is issued by the Financial Supervision Commission ("the Commission") in accordance with the powers conferred upon it under Section 22 of the Financial Supervision Act 1988.

The Commission has recently become aware of the above website which includes references to and claims to represent the above entity. The website claims that the above entity occupies an address at Bullock Hill House, Bucks Road, Douglas, Isle of Man, IM99 2QS. Research by the Commission has indicated that the postcode given by this entity is solely that of the Isle of Man Companies Registry. The Isle of Man Companies Registry is operated by the Financial Supervision Commission. The Commission can therefore confirm categorically that this postcode is not connected in any way to this entity. The address of Bullock Hill House, Bucks Road, Douglas, Isle of Man cannot be traced. However, the address of the Isle of Man Companies Registry and the Financial Supervision Commission is Finch Hill House, Bucks Road, Douglas, Isle of Man.

The entity is not a company incorporated within the jurisdiction of the Isle of Man. It is not registered as a foreign company having established a place of business on the Isle of Man. It is not registered as a business name on the Isle of Man.

The entity is not licensed or authorised by the Financial Supervision Commission to undertake banking, investment or corporate service provider business. A list of all institutions licensed by the Commission is available on our website at www.fsc.gov.im.

Telephone numbers quoted by Stonewood Securities Limited seen by the Commission are not Isle of Man numbers. They appear to be numbers supplied by United Kingdom telecom providers.

The Commission has established no association between the above entity and any genuine Isle of Man companies. The Commission has established no genuine links between this entity and the Isle of Man.

Under the circumstances, the Commission would strongly urge persons considering dealing with this entity to exercise the utmost caution before proceeding, bearing in mind the contents of this public notice.
