



## WARNING ISSUED TO THE PUBLIC ABOUT RECOMMENDATIONS ON FRAUDULENT SECURITIES FOR SPANISH INVESTORS

11 July 2018

The Spanish National Securities Market Commission (CNMV), in collaboration with the French Financial Markets Authority (AMF), has warned investors about the existence of fraudulent practices aimed at Spanish investors which are carried out by entities not registered in France.

These unauthorised entities introduce themselves as asset management companies, with the aim of making investment proposals to investors (by telephone or face-to-face). They usually employ aggressive sales tactics and promise high returns in order to encourage investors to invest in such products and thus allow unregistered entities to sell their securities at a high price.

This type of fraud can affect companies with securities traded on European markets and harm investors across the continent.

Currently, the shares recommended by these entities are Arthur Maury, Design your Home, Gentlemen's Equity, Orclass and Sumo Resources, which are listed on the Euronext market.

CNMV recommends investors to exercise extreme caution and, before investing, always check whether or not the entity is duly registered.
