Pursuant to article 227 of Legislative Royal Decree 4/2015, of 23 October, enacting the consolidated text of the Securities Market Act, Aena S.M.E., S.A. (“**Aena**” or the “**Company**”) reports the following:

DISCLOSURE OF OTHER RELEVANT INFORMATION

On 21 December 2021, the Board of Directors of Aena approved the airport charges applicable as of 1 March 2022, once the formalities set forth in Law 18/2014 had been completed. These charges represent a decrease of -3.17% of the maximum adjusted annual revenue per passenger in 2022 compared to 2021, setting this year at €9.95 per passenger.

Today, the National Markets and Competition Commission (**CNMC or the Commission**) has notified this Company of the supervisory resolution of these 2022 airport charges, declaring the charges approved by the Board of Aena to be complaint and applicable.

On 3 February 2022, the CNMC notified Aena of the initiation of a dispute procedure regarding the modification of the 2022 airport charges, requested by IATA Spain and Ryanair, which does not affect their application as of 1 March. The Company believes that this procedure will not result in any modification of the charges approved by Aena and already supervised by the Commission.

Finally, on 16 February 2022, the Executive Committee of the Board of Directors of Aena approved an incentive for the 2022 summer season to increase passenger traffic and an incentive for regular commercial helicopter operations from the heliports of Ceuta and Algeciras for the summer and winter seasons.
